Recreational Program Registration Spring 2012

Registration Dead Line: February 24, 2012

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE: Please make sure that all registration materials are filled out properly and postmarked by **February 24, 2012**. Registrations that are not filled out completely or are missing payment or forms or are postmarked later than **February 24, WILL NOT BE PROCESSED**. We will hold the registrations received after this deadline and use to fill out the remaining player slots for each team. These will be used on a first received, first placed basis.

Use this set of forms for **Recreational** play only. They can also be found at the LAYSL Forms web page. Each child playing will need a full set of registration material turned in. Below is a checklist to help ensure all documents are turned in.

We need all the information requested. Make sure you provide the legal name, including middle initial, and the gender of the player. Note: The state has new registration software and **Mother's Month and Day of Birth** is required for players ID numbers. **Mail your completed forms along with your registration fees to, LAYSL, P.O. Box 649, Los Alamos, NM 87544.**

FEES: For each child registered, submit the fee for that child's age bracket. Families with 3 or more children pay \$30.00 less for the 3rd and subsequent children; the 1st and 2nd children pay the full fee. Registration will not be processed until this fee is received in full.

AGE GROUPS: Any child born between August 1, 1995 and July 31, 2005 is eligible to play in LAYSL REC program. **Players are assigned by age**, not grade. See the on-line table as well to help with age groups at: <http://www.laysl.org/cgi-bin/reg/agegroups.cgi>

Sometimes it is necessary to combine age groups if registration numbers are too small to field sufficient teams or there are not enough coaching volunteers.

GIRLS-ONLY TEAMS: LAYSL organizes all-girl divisions in U10, U12 & U14 groups only, and only if there are enough applications. Girls may choose to play in either division.

PLAY-UPS: Any player can request to "play-up"/"play down" one birth year. **A LAYSL "Exception Form" must be submitted and the play-up release waiver on the NMYSA registration form must be signed.** No child may play more than one birth year outside their age bracket. This includes those children born in August. If you do not specify otherwise, your child will be placed with the age group, NOT the grade. **A player cannot be moved once his/her registration has been processed.**

WITHDRAWAL FEES: Players withdrawing after their registration has been processed will be charged a withdrawal fee of \$40. Refunds are issued after all the registrations for those children who are playing have been completed. Once the first week of practices has passed, there will be no refunds. There is an appeal process where you can write a letter and present your case to the board of directors. **Once a player withdraws from the League, he/she may not practice or play with any LAYSL team.**

DUAL-ROSTERED PLAYERS: Any player who will be dual-rostered (playing with both a recreational and an advanced team) must first fill out the competitive program forms for their competitive team coach, and then fill out the recreational forms for the Recreational Registrar. Please note on both LAYSL forms that your child is dual-rostering. Pay only the competitive program fee.

PRACTICE AND GAMES SCHEDULES: Most teams practice twice a week for 1 to 1-1/2 hours, with days and times subject to field and coach availability. Games are generally played on Friday evenings or Saturday mornings. U6 have two scrimmages a week but do not have weekend games. Practices for Fall start roughly the end of August through the end of October. The Spring season roughly begins in early March through the middle of May, with a break during Spring Break

TEAM FORMATION: Teams are formed by age groups with the emphasis on balanced teams. Recreation Coordinators and Coaches endeavor to create teams of balanced strength, while trying to honor special requests of practice location, practice times and co-players. No guarantee is made. Normally, Los Alamos and White Rock localized teams are created. In smaller divisions, players may be assigned to the Hill even if they live in White Rock or vice versa. In general, teams are kept together for both the Fall and Spring seasons with adjustments for vacancies. **There is no guarantee that your child will be given the same coach as in the previous registration year.**

TRANSFERRING TEAMS: There will be a \$50 transfer fee. The coach of the team losing a player and the coach of the team gaining a player will both receive \$20 and the league will receive \$10 for administrative fees. It will also be a requirement that another player from the team gaining a player will have to swap and pay the same fees. It is imperative that the league office be made aware of these transfers due to our insurance rider requiring knowledge of where every child is assigned. We also need to ensure the coaches have accurate medical information for each child, like allergies and existing conditions. Failure to notify the league office of a transfer could result in penalty, including expulsion from the league.

SPECIAL REQUESTS: There is NO guarantee that special requests will be honored, however special needs for time, site and day may be requested on the LAYSL form. Failure to do so on the LAYSL form **at the time of registration** will forfeit your choice. Requests for specific Coaches or specific Teammates will not be given consideration and **cannot be honored**.

UNIFORMS: If you have a jersey from the 2009-10 season, then you do not need to purchase a new shirt, unless your child has out-grown their shirt. The reversible LAYSL jersey, shin-guards, socks, cleats and other equipment may be purchased at CB Fox. It is highly recommended that your child have a soccer ball of the appropriate size with which to practice. ***Shin guards are required and must be worn for all practices, scrimmages and games.***

JEWELRY: NO jewelry is allowed to be worn at games or practices. This includes any earrings, hairpins, body piercing, or watches with the exception of Medic Alert badges, which must be taped to the arm while playing. Every year, we hear stories about kids getting their ears pierced for the first time. This is not an acceptable excuse and the piercings will have to be removed before the player is allowed to participate.

VOLUNTEERS: LAYSL cannot function without the help of parent volunteers. **Each team needs a coach, an assistant coach, referees and assistant referees (linespersons), and team parents.** We are particularly short on coach volunteers. Free clinics are available each season for those who would like to coach, referee or be an assistant referee. If enough volunteer coaches are not found for a certain age groups, the league may require an additional fee be levied against all participants in that age group in order to hire additional coaches. Registration fees are returned for certain volunteer positions (see the LAYSL form for details). Please volunteer to help by indicating your preference on the LAYSL form. Thank you!
